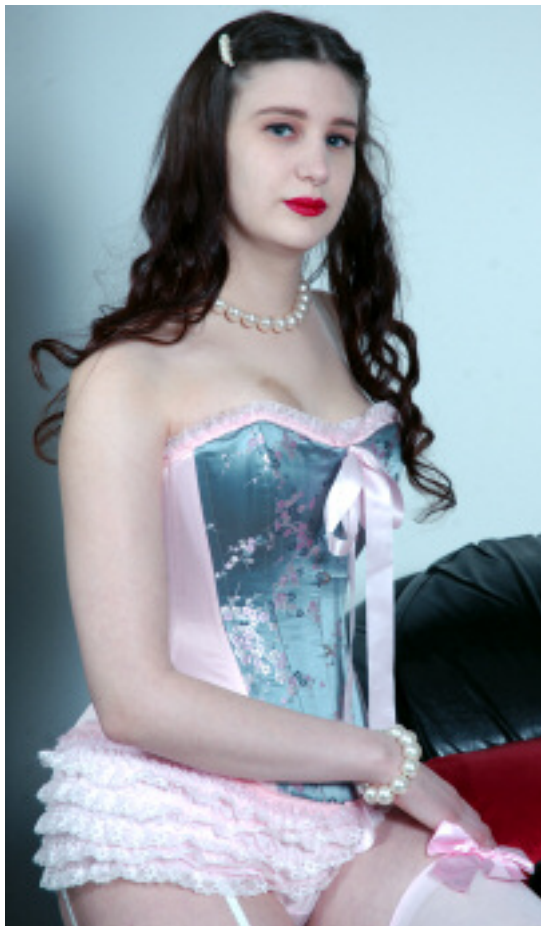
Wednesday 6 August
